Contexte

En cas de catastrophes naturelles, la communauté internationale et les ONG volent souvent au secours des victimes.

B-Support

Text: RECENT CATASTROPHIC EARTHQUAKE IN SYRIA AND TURKEY.

1- A third, 6.4 magnitude earthquake has struck southern Turkey a fortnight after two powerful earthquakes hit southern Turkey and northern Syria, killing over 44,000 people. The earthquakes are estimated to have directly impacted 23 million people across Turkey and Syria. The earthquake has destroyed thousands of people's homes in Turkey and Syria while hospitals, roads and bridges have been badly damaged. The impacts were so large that tremors were reported as far away as Cyprus, Lebron, Iraq and Jordan. The probability of finding more people alive has fallen considerably, and the focus has now shifted to providing essential support for survivors who have lost their homes, belongings, livelihoods and loved ones. Extensive damage has been reported in Turkey and Syria with buildings collapsing in cities. Emergency damage responders from the Turkish Red Crescent and Syrian Arab Red Crescent are on the ground providing urgent humanitarian relief and supporting rescue efforts.

2-The Turkish Red Crescent launched a crisis response operation immediately after the first earthquake, mobilizing teams in more than ten regions across the country. Over 5,500 staff and volunteers are involved, supporting with search and rescue and providing basic relief items including 46,000 blankets and 3,000 tents. More

than 350 mobile kitchens and 86 catering trucks have been deployed to provide food for people in the coming weeks. As this has happened during the winter and the temperatures are currently very low, the Turkish Red Crescent is aiming to deliver over 50,000 blankets, 10,000 electric heaters, 25,000 sleeping bags and 25,000 beds to the region.

3-The British Red Cross has existing programs in Aleppo and other areas of Syria where we provide cash support to vulnerable and disaster-affected communities as our humanitarian work is not subjected to financial sanctions. Our work is targeted to save lives and promote human dignity in recovery, and funds raised will support people in Aleppo in multiple ways: funds from the appeal will help the relief effort and to support those who have lost their loved ones and who, in many cases, have been left with nothing. The money will also help the ongoing rescue efforts and immediate relief as well as longer term aid for those affected. Our emergency responders are on the ground now, assisting in relief efforts and providing emergency support to people affected by the earthquakes. Together, we are the world's emergency responders.
